Membership Description

Wiley's Pack works with the JJC Communications and Marketing Division to promote the college by developing promotional content to share across social media and in person in order to engage with current students, employees and our community.

Terms of Membership

- Period is for the 2022-2023 academic year.
- Must maintain a 2.5 GPA or higher.
- Be currently enrolled in a certificate or degree program at JJC.
- Attend JJC fall 2022.
- Be in good financial standing with JJC.
- Have no criminal history.
- Allow JJC to use your photo/image/likeness for the purposes of promoting the college.
- Attend the mandatory orientation and photo/video shoot in fall 2022.
- Acknowledge that JJC Communications and Marketing has sole creative control over photos and videos chosen for all marketing materials.
- Have at least one public media account and allow JJC to follow and repost any post associated with Wiley's Pack.
- Keep track of hours worked and number of social media posts.
- Review and adhere to JJC's social media procedure.
- Post and/or participate in content creation events a minimum of 3 times each month.
- Tag all posts with @jolietjrcollege and #wileyspackjjc.
- Promote, attend and comment on JJC events/activities on social media using the hashtags.
- Join the Wiley's Pack internal chat thread (email and/or messaging app) to receive communications.
- Check email and chat thread regularly. Respond promptly.
- Wear your Wiley's Pack swag around campus/community and in social posts, when able.
- Adhere to all policies described in the JJC Student Code of Conduct.

- Qualifications for reappointment during the next academic year are dependent upon successful fulfillment of the above expectations.
- Participate in an interview for the purpose of creating a Wiley's Pack student profile.

Moral Responsibilities

Continued Membership

- Dependability
- Maintain 2.5 GPA or higher
- Continued enrollment in degree or certificate program
- Remain in good standing with Office of Student Rights and Responsibilities

Possible Grounds for Membership Termination

- Disregard of Wiley's Pack terms, JJC social procedures and/or Student Code of Conduct.
- Wearing inappropriate clothing or nudity in social media posts
- Inappropriate language in social media posts
- Showing underage use of alcohol, drug use or obscene gestures in social media posts
- Threats or use of physical force
- Destruction of college property
- Illegal activities conducted on college property including alcohol and drug use
- Excessive tardiness or no-shows
